The Town Council of the Town of Sussex met in special session, by appointment of the Mayor of the said Town, in the Council Chambers of the said Town on Monday the 25th day of September, 2006, at 6:30 o'clock in the evening.

The following members of the Council were present: His Worship Mayor Carr, Deputy Mayor Thorne, Councillors Fulton, Wright, Wilson and Black. Councillor Bradley was absent. Also present at this meeting were the Town Clerk/Treasurer, Paul Maguire and Chief Administrative Officer, Michael Cummings.

It was moved by Councillor Black, seconded by Councillor Wilson, that the agenda for this special Town Council meeting be approved. Motion carried.

No members present declared a conflict of interest on any items on the agenda at this time.

The purpose of this special Council meeting was to hear objections to the Town of Sussex Zoning By-Law Amendment, By-Law # 1350-04-05. The by-law amendment made changes to Section 370 - Fences and/or Hedges, Lots and Other Standards, Section 210 - Central Business District, Section 340 - Parking and Loading, Section 360 – Signs and Section 130 - Single and Two-Family Residential and Up To and Including Six-Family Residential. The Town Clerk informed the Council that the Town had received no written objections to the proposed Zoning By-Law Amendment.

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His Worship Mayor Carr noted that there was no one present at the Council meeting who was objecting to the proposed amendments.

It was moved by Councillor Wright, seconded by Councillor Wilson, that this special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Sussex adjourn. Motion carried.
