The Town Council of the Town of Sussex met in special session, by appointment of the Mayor of the said Town, in the Council Chambers of the said Town on Thursday the 20th day of March, 2008, at 6:00 o'clock in the evening.

The following members of the Council were present: His Worship Mayor Carr, Deputy Mayor Thorne, Councillors Campbell, Wright, Black, Wilson and Fulton. Councillor Bradley was absent. Also present at this meeting was the Town Clerk/Treasurer, Paul Maguire.

It was moved by Councillor Wright, seconded by Councillor Black, that the agenda for this special Town Council meeting be approved. Motion carried.

No members present declared a conflict of interest on any items on the agenda at this time.

The purpose of this special Council meeting was to have a hearing of objections to the Zoning By-Law Amendment, By-Law # 1350-04-13. The proposed amendment would rezone a parcel of land located on the east side of Eveleigh Street, having P.I.D. # 30205876 on G.I.C. map # 10R29NE, from an Industrial Light zone to an Industrial Light zone permitting a motel with terms and conditions.

The Town Clerk informed the Council that the Town had received no written objections and His Worship Mayor Carr noted that there was no one present at the meeting who was objecting to the proposed by-law amendment.
