SUSSEX BASEMENT FLOODING PREVENTION SUBSIDY,

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Town of Sussex (the "Town") supports local residents in the taking of proactive measures to mitigate the risk of basement flooding events through the Basement Flooding Prevention Subsidy Program (the "Program"). These Terms and Conditions are set out to govern conditions of any support between the Town and the Applicant as part of the Program.

- 1. Work is defined as any of the following;
 - a. Disconnection of downspouts from the sanitary sewer system.
 - b. Disconnection of weeping tiles form the sanitary sewer system and installation of a sump pump system with battery backup.
 - c. Installation of a National Building Code of Canada approved backwater valve. (Homeowner will only qualify for a backwater valve subsidy if they have demonstrated they do not have any downspouts or weeping tile / foundation drain connections to the sanitary sewer system.)
- 2. Completed Work is defined as Work that is fully functional and acceptable under industry standards. Work is only deemed "Complete" upon meeting the National Building Code of Canada standards as approved at the time of the Application and approved by the Building Inspector of the Town.
- 3. All Work, and Inspection of Work, is to be coordinated by the homeowner.
- 4. The homeowner is responsible for the on-going operation and maintenance of all equipment installed as part of the Work.
- 5. The Homeowner must sign the Town's application form and Waiver form, releasing the Town form any and all liability resulting from Work carried out as part of the Town' Basement Flooding Prevention Subsidy Program.
- 6. Reimbursement will occur upon satisfactory review of the submitted required forms and associated documentation, and the Work being declared Complete. A Cheque will be mailed out within 4 to 6 weeks of receipt of an acceptable and complete application.
- 7. The Town will not be held responsible for any maintenance or warranty, with respect to the performance, capabilities, or failures of any Work, devise, or workmanship related to any Work performed as participation in any part of this Subsidy Program.
- 8. The Town reserves the right to accept or reject, at its sole and absolute discretion, any application or any part thereof.
- 9. At any time and for any reason, the Town may terminate the program and refuse any or all further applications. Any such decisions may be made in the Town's sole and absolute discretion.
- 10. Failure to meet any or all conditions of the Terms and Conditions may result in application refusal, disentitlement to any subsidy, and / or refusal of future applications to the Program.
