

GUIDELINES FOR

OUTDOOR BURNING



If you live within Sussex, outdoor wood-burning appliances are regulated under By-law 350-12, which outlines fire prevention measures and safety requirements.

This by-law permits:

- ✓ Use of CSA Approved Appliances on a non-flammable base
- ✓ Keeping 3 Meters from anything nearby
- ✓ Closely Supervised Fires
- ✓ Burning when there is NO FIRE BAN in effect




CSA APPROVED APPLIANCE



STAY 3M AWAY FROM ANY BUILDING, PROPERTY LINE, TREE, ETC.



SUPERVISE AT ALL TIMES WITH A WORKING GARDEN HOSE OR FIRE EXTINGUISHER CLOSE BY, READY TO USE






FIRE BANS:




Use of wood-burning appliances **is prohibited when a burn ban is in effect**, as issued by the Province of New Brunswick.

The burn status is updated every day at 2:00 PM. Before lighting any outdoor wood-burning device, confirm the status:  [GNB Fire Watch](https://www.gnbfirewatch.ca)

 DO NOT BURN:

-  Painted or pressure-treated wood
-  Garbage, food scraps, or plastics
-  Large branches, brush, yard debris

 BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR:

-  Let neighbours know first
-  Avoid Windy Conditions
-  Consider those with allergies or sensitivities
