The Town of Sussex is pleased to announce that we are reviewing the Town's Municipal Plan and Zoning Bylaw in 2019. Approved, in 2010, the Town's existing Municipal Plan has served the Town well; however, it is time to review and update it, based on provisions set forth by the New Brunswick *Community Planning Act.*

As part of the process, the Town will be engaging residents, business-owners, community groups, and other local stakeholders to develop a new vision for how Sussex will facilitate and manage growth over the next 10 years, while still maintaining the values that contribute to making Sussex a proudly rural, quaintly charming community. The Town's Municipal Plan is the most significant guiding document that establishes a vision for the Town and establishes policies and proposals in a number of important areas, including, land use, transportation systems, natural environment, recreation, and public realm, to name a few.

Throughout this process, the Town will be actively engaging residents, businesses, developers, and community groups on a number of key issues. In addition to online engagement, the Town will host a number of public information sessions related to the Plan Review. The first sessions will be held between August 21st, 2019 and Aug 23rd, 2019 during the Celebrate Downtown Sussex events.
