

**A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE A PORTION OF  
SUNNYSIDE DRIVE IN THE TOWN OF SUSSEX  
TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC**

**BY-LAW # 1005**

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of Sussex pursuant to Section 186A of the Municipalities Act as follows.

The Council of the Town of Sussex does hereby stop up and close to vehicular traffic a portion of the highway located in the said Town of Sussex and known as Sunnyside Drive, more particularly described as follows:

“a strip of land of a uniform width of 50 feet extending from the easterly boundary of Hillside Crescent at the eastern entrance of said street, and thence in an easterly direction to the western boundary of Kirk Hill Cemetery Limited lands.”
